

Income Eligibility Guidelines Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)

2019 - 2020 Season

Maximum gross household income is based on the number of people in the household.

For households with more than 10 persons, contact your Community Action Agency (CAA) for eligibility guidelines.

Other program guidelines and requirements may apply - your CAA will provide you with all the details.

If you pay court ordered child support, you may be able to deduct the amounts paid from your household's income.

If your household income is over the HEAP income guidelines, you may be able to deduct a portion of the amount you paid for medical expenses.

WHAT TO BRING TO YOUR FUEL ASSISTANCE APPOINTMENT:

Proof of **GROSS** income for previous 3 or 12 months

Name, date of birth and SS number verification document for each household member

Unexpired photo ID of Primary applicant

A current Light bill, Fuel company and Account number (for those who pay their own heat)

Rent certification for those in *subsidized housing* (in effect on the date of HEAP application)

Further documentation may be requested during HEAP appointment, as needed.
