At least 48 hours before the vaccine appointment, individuals should call 1-855-608-5172 to reserve a ride and should have the following information ready:

- Date and time of appointment
- Name, address, and phone number of the facility where they are receiving the vaccination

- Personal contact information including address, phone and next of kin
